



CORE – Website improvements 06-04-16

At the start of the 2016/17 reporting year, we have been able to release some further improvements to our website. Details of the improvements are as follows:

- **Coordinators are now able to reopen valid logs**
From 06-04-16 users no longer need to email the CORE Helpdesk with requests to reopen logs, as it is now possible for Coordinators to reopen valid logs submitted by their managed Data Providers. Data Providers who require their logs to be reopened should contact their Coordinator.
- **Supported Housing downloads complete**
Downloads of valid and invalid record level SRSB and ARSB logs now contain previously missing fields. Please note that information on logs' Managing Organisations will only be available for logs submitted after 12-10-15 on the DCLG CORE website.
- **Confidential schemes update**
As new schemes are created, it is now possible to indicate if they are confidential. Any schemes set up prior to October 2015 without postcodes will not be flagged as confidential, but the postcodes remain unavailable. Please review your organisation's confidential schemes, and let the CORE helpdesk know if any should be marked as confidential. Please continue to refrain from entering the postcode for any confidential schemes.
- **Supported Housing scheme selection**
It is no longer possible to incorrectly select an unapproved scheme when entering Supported Housing Logs.

In addition to the above changes, the Lettings and Sales logs are available to download as .pdf from the [Guides and Manuals](#) page of our website, along with the Lettings eCORE specification for 2016-17 and the 2016-17 Manual. The data dictionaries will follow in due course.
